



Clinton Presbyterian 91 Center Street Join us on Sunday, September 10th, as we come together in worship to begin the Fall season together. After worship we'll head outside (weather permitting!) for an all-church breakfast filled with delicious food.





The **Praise Team** leads us in contemporary music in worship. They rehearse on Saturday mornings at 10 am. **Rehearsals begin on September 16.** Singers and musicians are always invited to join this team and use their gifts to praise God.

The **Chancel Choir** sings approximately twice a month from September through May. Rehearsals are on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 pm, **beginning September 20**. The choir engages a variety of styles of music including classical, gospel and modern. Experience reading music is helpful. You do not have to be a member of CPC to join the chancel choir and no audition is necessary. Please join us as we seek to glorify God through music. The **Bell Choir** will present a musical offering twice this fall, on Sunday, October 15 and on Sunday, December 3. Watch the bulletin for more details on rehearsals. Bell Choir is open to people over the age of 10, as long as they can count! No musical knowledge is needed.

At CPC, our **Children's Chorus** offers songs throughout the year. All kids from Preschool through 6th grade are welcome to join. Rehearsals are scheduled during the Sunday School hour. Children's Chorus offering dates for the upcoming year: Christmas Pageant -December 17, Christmas Eve 5pm service, Children's Sunday - February 11, 2024 and Palm Sunday - March 24.

We love children at CPC! Children are always welcome to stay in worship with their families. You will find "Busy Bags" at the front and the back of the sanctuary filled with quiet activities for little hands. Each week we have a special Children's Conversation during worship. Children ages 6 and under are welcome to go to the nursery following this time or remain in the sanctuary. Nursery care is provided for infants for the entirety of the worship service should parents desire it.

Sunday School classes for all ages will begin on Sunday, September 17


Sunday School for Preschool and Elementary





Box City 2023: October 21 (Virtual)

With the opening and dedication of The Promise Center happening, Family Promise decided to change the date for their Box City event to October 21st this year. Family Promise of Hunterdon County exists to prevent homelessness and to provide critical services to our neighbors. They want to give ample attention to the plight of homelessness in Hunterdon through Box City. More information on this event will be shared as it becomes available.



The Flemington Area Food Pantry provides food and personal care items to people in Hunterdon County who are food insecure. Food insecurity is a national problem. In Hunterdon County, of 126,000 residents, an estimated 5,000 have income below the poverty level.

Many of these residents, including children and infants, don't get enough to eat without some form of assistance. The Pantry provides supplemental groceries to approximately 1,600 income qualified Hunterdon County families. mission dollars from CPC help support the work of the Food Pantry. 


Trunk or Treat CPC Parking Lot on Tuesday, October 31 from 5 to 7 pm
